#### Grand Palace & Wat Pho

We will visit Wat Phra Kaew and the nearby attractions first, before moving on to the Grand Palace. Wat Phra Kaew, or the Temple of the Emerald Buddha, is located right next to the Grand Palace, and they probably form together the greatest spectacle for visitors in Bangkok. A visit to the Royal Grand Palace, the nation's landmark, and most praised royal monument in Thailand, is a must. The palace, which is the former royal residence of the Chakri Kings, is the perfect example of an ancient Siamese court. Built in 1782 by the King Rama I, it was the centre of power for more than 150 years. Today, the palace is Bangkok's major landmark and most popular tourist attraction. Indeed, the Grand Palace is an amazing place to visit, as it consists of over 100 brightly colored buildings, golden spires, and glittering mosaics, that all date back to the foundation of Bangkok in 1782.

Please note that photography is permitted in the Royal Palace Grounds and in the compounds of the Emerald Buddha Temple, but not inside the buildings



"**Wat Pho**" with its Reclining Buddha image. Wat Pho is regarded as the first centre of public education and is sometimes called 'Thailand's first university'. Mural paintings, inscriptions, and statues found in the temple educated people on various subjects such as literature, warfare, archaeology, astronomy, geology, meditation and is considered to be home of Thai traditional massages.

Dress Code: Please note that the chapel is a national shrine and that you will be required to wear proper attire (no bare shoulders, knees, or strapless-heel shoes). Shoes must be removed before entering the temple buildings as a matter of respect.

#### Half Day Klong Tour

Nineteenth-century Bangkok was laced with canals, giving the capital the designation of the 'Venice of the East'. Surviving canals as well as the Chao Phraya River, itself (meaning the River of Kings) provide memorable vignettes of a traditional waterborne way-of-life that has remained essentially unchanged over the centuries. The river and canals can conveniently be explored by public transport or via a traditional long tailed boat. The tour will finally take you to Wat Arun (Temple of Dawn), this famous Chao Phraya riverbank landmark, which is best known for its porcelain encrusted 79-metre central sparkling pagoda. After a wonderful tour, we will bring you back across the river to the main starting point

#### Morning Damnern Saduak Floating Market

This interesting half-day tour will take you to the rural yet world-famous floating market of Damnern Saduak, situated around 100 kilometers west of Bangkok. It is generally known as Klong Ton Khem Floating Market or Damnern Saduak Floating Market. Damnern Saduak has officially three floating markets. A narrow canal flanked with food stalls and souvenir shops forms the principal market. Photographers at Ton Kem will get their best shots from the bridge which crosses over the canal and from the shed on the right. Nowadays, the market is bustling with activity from very early in the morning until about 11.00 am. For those who want to buy some memorabilia here, do not forget to bargain!

Phuket Old Town "Thalang Road" is famed for its Chino Portuguese architecture, cashew nut factories. Additionally, guests who like to shop will not be disappointed as stops at local gemstone shop for local souvenirs and gift are also on the agenda before retuning back to your hotel Overnight in Phuket
