ITINERARY: -

Day 01: Arrive at Bangkok airport

As soon as you disembark, our airport representative will meet you at the end of the jet bridge, holding a signboard with your name(s) on it. Accompany the representative to the exclusive fast lane immigration counter where the airport representative will assist you with all immigration and customs documentation. After clearing immigration, our representative will escort you to the baggage claim to collect your luggage and lead you through arrivals hall to meet your guide followed by a transfer to the hotel. Rest of the day free and Night stay at The Peninsula Bangkok Hotel 5* / Deluxe or similar.

Day 02: In Bangkok

- ❖ GRAND PALACE AND CITY TEMPLES (WAT PHO AND WAT ARUN)

Drive to **Wat Pho** - one of the oldest temples in Bangkok, Wat Pho houses the famous 45m (148ft) Reclining Buddha as well as the original school of traditional Thai massage. From here, continue to the spectacular **Grand Palace**. The vast 94ha (233ac) grounds encompass more than 100 buildings including the Royal Residence and Throne Halls, government offices and the renowned Wat Phra Kaew, home to the most revered Buddha image in Thailand, the Emerald Buddha (which is actually made of jade or jasper, rather than emerald). Next, walk to the local pier and take a join-in local ferry to **Wat Arun**, once the grand royal temple to King Rama II. Notice its impressive 82m (269ft) high Khmer-style tower and the many detailed floral mosaics made from broken Chinese porcelain, brought over by Chinese ships as ballast. Return to your hotel for Night stay.

- ❖ Availability: Morning, Afternoon
- ❖ Suggested departure times: 08:00; 13:00
- ❖ Approximate duration: 4 hours

- ❖ Opening times: Wat Pho is open daily from 08:30 to 18:00. The Grand Palace is open daily from 08:30 to 15:30, except when there are special royal ceremonies or when it is used for state functions. Wat Arun is open daily from 08:00 to 17:30
- ❖ Please bring a copy of your passport for security check before entering the palace.
- ❖ The monk's chanting ritual only in the morning and subject to change without prior notice. (please contact with Travel consultant if guests wish to attend this activity in the morning).
- ❖ For religious reasons, women should wear short-sleeved tops with full-length trousers or knee-length skirts and men should wear trousers and short-sleeved shirts. No shorts or flip-flops allowed
- ❖ These following clothes are strictly not allowed in Grand Palace: Shorts, mini-skirts, short skirts, tight fitting trousers, and tights; See-through shirts and blouses, as well as culottes or quarter length trousers; Sleeveless shirts or vests; Sandals (without ankle or heel straps); Rolled-up-sleeved shirts; Sweatshirts and sweatpants, windcheaters, pajamas, and fisherman trousers
- ❖ In the event of extreme traffic conditions, our driver may take you to the pier (located directly across from the Peninsula hotel) to transfer you by their shuttle boat in order to save time; or vice versa. Our guide will accompany you to and/or from the Peninsula.

Day 03: In Bangkok

❖ DISCOVER MAEKLONG RAILWAY MARKET & DAMNOEN SADUAK FLOATING MARKET

Depart early morning for the two hour drive to the Damnoen Saduak floating market. En route first visit at Maeklong Railway Market, the name says it all: it is a market which has a train running right through the middle of it, multiple times a day.

The market offers everything you expect a Thai market to offer but the Maeklong Railway Market differentiates itself from the other markets by having a railway located in the middle. If the products for sale are not placed on the railway itself, they are placed really close to it. Every time the train is about to drive through, the vendors recognize the warning bell and they immediately jump out of their chairs to pull back their awnings and when needed their products as well so the train will not hit the vendors' belongings. Tourists and the vendors gather together very close, but far enough, along the railway to let the train pass by safely. Right after the train has passed the stands, the vendors immediately place their belongings back at the railway and it looks like nothing has happened. Then we continue drive to Damnoen Saduak Floating Market, to see the traditional way of selling and buying goods in Thailand. Drive back to Bangkok and arrive at the hotel in time for lunch (not included).

**NOTES:**

- ❖ Availability: EARLY Morning ONLY
- ❖ Suggested time: 07.00 and the duration: 5 - 6 hours
- ❖ After tour will arrive Bangkok around 13.00 – 14.00 hrs depend on the boat traffic at the market and local or road conditions. So, any consecutive tours after this should be is City tour in Bangkok only by start after 14.00 hrs and without lunch time. Or can be arranged to evening tours instead to get more relax before at the hotel before the tour

- ❖ Availability: Evening only; And Close out festive days may apply e.g., Loy Krathong, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve, New Year's Day, Valentine's Day etc.
- ❖ Suggested departure time: 19:00 and approximate duration: 3.5 hours.

Day 05: at Chiang Mai

- ❖ HALF DAY VISIT KANTA ELEPHANT SANCTUARY (No Training Hook/ No Ankle Chain/ No Riding)

A half-day package to **Kanta Elephant Sanctuary** offers visitors an enjoyable opportunity to spend quality time with elephants in their natural home, as well as gain an insight into their history and behavior, and create cherished lifelong memories of their time spent with these amazing animals with friendly, happy elephants in a safe and sustainable environment.

07.00: Drive approximately 50-Mins North of Chiang Mai through a beautiful countryside, forest, and local farming areas.

08.00: Arrive at **Kanta Elephant Sanctuary**. Walk through and learn about the elephants, change into traditional clothing, and prepare fruits for our elephants.



09.00: Meet the elephants. Feed, interact, and play with the elephants in a natural environment and learn about their behavior and history. Take photos with the elephants.

10.00: Walk with the elephants to a clean water pond where they will cool off themselves and you will have chance to observe them as well.

11.00: Get some tea, coffee and season fruit then say goodbye to the elephants. Leave Baan Chang Elephant Park and drive approximately 50 Mins back to Chiang Mai. Drop off at your hotel or accommodation.

PLEASE NOTE:

- ❖ At the Park, we will allow you to spend as much time as possible with the elephants. Therefore, there is no formal schedule and aside from pick-up times, the times shown here are approximations.
- ❖ WHAT TO BRING: Hat/ Towel/ Bathing Suit/ Walking Shoes/ Sunscreen/ Change of Clothes and Under wear/ Insect Repellent/ Camera (Optional)
- ❖ PRICE INCLUDES: Pick up and drop off by **Kanta Elephant Sanctuary** from your place or accommodation. English speaking Guide. Accident Insurance. Snack and Seasonal Fruit (NO LUNCH). Drinking Water. Food for Feed Elephants

☞ CITY LIFESTYLE, DOI SUTHEP & RICKSHAW RIDE

In the afternoon, you will visit to a vibrant **food and flower market** where local Thais do their shopping. Continue to **Wat Suan Dok**, final resting place for the ashes of former kings of Chiang Mai and the Royal Family. Drive 30min to **Doi Suthep Mountain**, enjoying the spectacular views of Northern Thailand as you head past mountains and forests, towards **Wat Phra That**, one of Northern Thailand's most sacred temples. Founded in 1383 AD, the temple is reached by **climbing 309 steps** (or for the less fitness-minded, a tram is available for a small surcharge). The climb up is rewarded with a **superb panoramic view over the city**. Return to Chiang Mai and enjoy a **20min rickshaw ride** through the quiet streets of the old town before returning to your hotel.

NOTES:

- ❖ Availability: Afternoon.
- ❖ Suggested Departure time: 13:00.
- ❖ Approximate duration: 4.5 Hours.
- ❖ Out of respect for the local culture, ladies should cover their shoulders with a long- or short-sleeved top and full-length trousers or a knee-length skirt. Gentlemen should wear trousers and a long- or short-sleeved shirt.
