Moscow - Murmansk - St. Petersburg



08 Days / 07 Nights

Day 01: Arrive Moscow

On arrival, you will be met by your car with chauffeur for the short transfer to your hotel for night stay.

Lunch at the restaurant

Afternoon Sightseeing tour of the Russian capital - here you will see places of interest, architectural monuments and museums that are among the finest in the world: the main street-Tverskaya, the Cathedral of Christ the Savior, the monument to Peter I on the Moscow river, Moscow state University-the oldest University in Russia and the largest University building in the world. You will walk on the observation deck of the Sparrow hills- this is the cult place for all guests of the city, it offers a fascinating panorama of the city where you can see the stadium "Luzhniki", Novodevichy convent, skyscrapers of the business quarter "Moscow City", famous Stalin's skyscrapers and more.

Day 02: Visit Moscow

After breakfast meet your guide at the hotel lobby for sightseeing.

Guided tour around the Kremlin and one of the cathedrals - Moscow Kremlin is the oldest part of the city that contains within its walls a unique series of masterpieces of architecture and the plastic arts. The Kremlin is a UNESCO world heritage and considered one of the most beautiful and valued architectural ensembles in the world.

Guided tour to the Armory chamber is the oldest state Museum of Moscow, with an amazing richness and uniqueness of the exhibits. The Museum exhibits works of Russian, Western and Eastern art of the V-XX centuries, the throne of the Moscow tsars, Royal clothes and military armor, unique gold and silver dishes, Royal regalia, carriages, different centuries, a collection of weapons.

Moscow Metro Tour - Moscow Metro is more than just a transport system. It was created primarily as a symbol of the Soviet supremacy and industrial achievements. And once you descend underground, you will understand why the Moscow Metro is different from any other similar system in the world. Each station carries its individuality, decorated in a distinct style, and devoted to different events or symbols.

Walking tour for the Arbat Street - one of the symbols of Moscow and the most famous street. You will explore the Old Arbat, one of the oldest streets in Moscow, where craftsmen have practiced their crafts since the 15th century.

Teriberka Village - Teriberka is an ancient village in the Murmansk region on the shore of the Barents Sea. The history of these places is closely connected with fishing and harvesting. Nowadays, Teriberka attracts tourists with a unique opportunity to go to the "edge of the earth" and touch the breath of the Arctic ocean.

Excursion to Hermitage (main building)

After an interesting sightseeing tour, you will visit the Hermitage - this is one of the most important and largest museums in St. Petersburg. The museum has about three million works of art. In the museum you can visit the Great and Small Throne Room, the White Sea, the Alexander, the Armorial Hall, the Malachite Lounge, and other halls of the Winter Palace, but alone. Do not forget to pay attention to the famous watch "Peacock" and the extraordinary Hanging Garden!

Lunch at the local restaurant

City tour: The sightseeing tour of St. Petersburg is famous for its richness. In this walk all the advantages of the city are collected. The excursion covers all the most important sights of the northern capital. Long streets, huge squares, majestic temples, and cathedrals. You will see the main street of St. Petersburg Nevsky Prospect, as well as the most beautiful cathedrals such as Kazan Cathedral, Spas-on-the-Blood and of course the Palace Square, on which one of the most important museums of this city is located the Hermitage. You can watch Peter the Great's Lodge and one of the most enchanting architectural ensembles of Strelka of the Vasilievsky Island. In the first part of the journey, several stops will be made so that tourists can make unique photos.

Day 07: Visit Saint Petersburg

Excursion to Tsarskoe Selo

Another jewel in the crown of Saint Petersburg suburbs has the name of one of the greatest Russian poets Alexander Sergeyvich Pushkin and houses one of the most picturesque palace and park ensembles among the former residences of the Russian Emperors. This place gives you an opportunity to feel as a member of a royal family, to dive into the lives of the Empresses that occupied this place long time ago and to witness the marvelous beauty of the Amber Room single-handedly. Most of the visitors can hardly believe that almost everything inside the palace is a result of a careful restoration, which was finished less than 10 years ago. This also applies to the legendary Amber Room, the undisputable precious gem of the Catherine Palace, that went through many hardships throughout its history especially during World War II. But despite all the hardships the Catherine Palace and the Catherine Park still shine brightly, and nothing should stop you from visiting it.

St. Isaac Cathedral visit

One of the most famous and recognizable structures of St. Petersburg has always been and remains shrouded in mystery. From a mysterious death of the main architect to a strange connection between its construction and the fate of the Romanov house, this Cathedral is a unique place in every aspect. The cathedral's facades are decorated with sculptures and massive granite columns, while the interior is adorned with incredibly detailed mosaic icons, paintings and columns made of malachite and lapis lazuli.

The Church of the Savior on Spilled Blood

It differs a lot from other buildings in Saint Petersburg mainly due to its Russian style and the purpose of its construction. Church of the Savior on Spilled Blood was built in memory of Alexander II, who was assassinated in 1881. The church stands in the very place where a bomb was thrown into his carriage by a young man who opposed the Tsar's reforms. Alexander II was among the greatest Russian tsars, one of the main accomplishments of whom was the emancipation of serfs in 1861, which ended the de facto slavery of the Russian peasantry five years before the emancipation of slaves in the US. But not only history attracts people to this place. The look of the building is truly astonishing. Its five onion domes decorated and covered with jewel enamel can impress everyone. Its facade is similar to the one of St. Basil's Cathedral in Moscow and its peculiar multicolored exterior makes the cathedral stand out from St. Petersburg's typically strict architectural proportions and color combinations. Therefore, this sight is a must in North Venice of Russia.
